## Organization of Teaching and Learning at AIM University Group

### Optional Components:

- **Face-to-Face Tutorials:** Attending face-to-face tutorials is optional. The sessions offer personalized interaction with a tutor to support your coursework, practicum, and group assignments. Each tutorial group is limited to ten (10) learners to ensure individualized attention. These sessions are available in Kingston and Fort Lauderdale, with schedules provided on your timetable. Some sessions may coincide with ongoing online classes.
- **Panama Familiarization Trip:** This optional 7- to 30-day aviation and language immersion trip to Panama provides a practical review of the entire passenger journey, from check-in to deplaning. It also offers a cultural and language immersion experience in a native Spanish-speaking country, enhancing your aviation knowledge and practical skills.

### Compulsory Components:

- **Online Classes:** All learners are required to attend and participate in online classes via Zoom Conferencing. These sessions are vital for delivering core course content and providing an interactive platform for engaging with instructors and peers.
- **Coursework:** Learners must complete a series of online modules, open-book quizzes, and closed-book online tests as part of their coursework. These components are essential for reinforcing understanding and applying the concepts taught in the classes.
- **Term Papers:** Coursework also includes various assignments such as case studies, oral presentations, reports, practicums, group work, and editorials. These assignments are designed to meet OFQUAL standards and are crucial for assessing your academic progress and comprehension of the material.
