Optional Resit/Resubmission Opportunity

If you have passed the module overall, but you have an optional resit/resubmission opportunity on an item of assessment:

- You may resubmit this item of assessment, which may or may not improve your overall grade/classification.
- If the resit outcome is due to be confirmed by the Award Board **after** graduation, you can still attend the Graduation Ceremony. If the overall module grade has changed following confirmation of your optional resit/resubmission at the next Award Board, we will issue you with an updated Transcript of Studies. If your classification has changed, we will ask you to return your original Certificate and we will then issue you with a new Certificate.

Certificates & Transcripts

Your Certificate and Transcript will either be available **six weeks** from the date of the Award Board or will be presented to you at the Graduation Ceremony.

If you do not want to attend a ceremony you can complete the [online form](#) to have your certificate and transcript posted to you six weeks **after** the date of the Award Board.

Graduation Ceremonies

Our Graduation Ceremonies take place in February and July each year.

- To attend the February graduation, you must receive this email before the end of November. If you are eligible to attend the February graduation you will receive an email invitation to the ceremony in early September.
- To attend the July graduation, you must receive this email before the end of June/beginning of July. If you are eligible to attend the July graduation you should receive an email invitation to the ceremony by the first week of April.
